Permission slips were sent home yesterday. Please return them by Friday, 12th October latest if you wish your child to be photographed for this piece of public art.

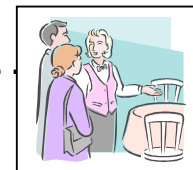
