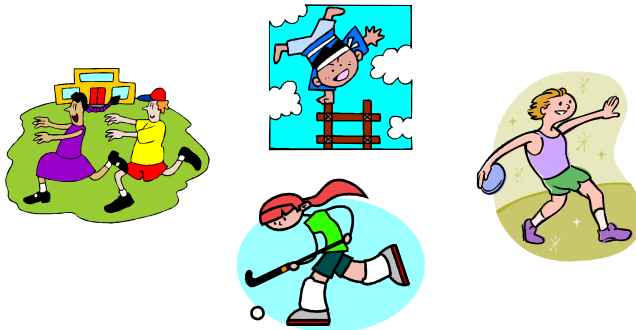


### ATTENDANCE
