We assess children all through the Nursery and Reception years using a national profile. At the end of 2003 / 4 we were well behind the MK average. By 2004 / 5 we were ahead and at the end of 2005 / 6 we were well ahead.

In 2005 - 6, we were in the top 25 schools in Milton Keynes.
